POSITION TITLE: Intelligence Analyst

POSITION LOCATION: Any field office in the United States

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The mission of the FBI is to protect the American people and uphold the Constitution of the United States. FBI Intelligence Analysts collect and gather information from a wide range of sources, draw conclusions, and make actionable and strategic recommendations to key decision makers on a variety of threats and cases. Working collaboratively alongside Special Agents, Linguists, Computer Scientists, and other investigative team members, Intelligence Analysts engage in work ranging from counterterrorism and organized crime, cyber and beyond. Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Collecting and combining disparate bits of information from a wide array of sources, such as local and national intelligence databases, as well as from information-sharing programs with local, state, federal, and international partners
- Using language, cultural, historical, and specialized knowledge to form an integrating picture of criminal, national security, and public safety matters
- Gather and analyze collected intelligence to develop fact-based, actionable conclusions which you will draft into intelligence reports and briefing materials
- Consolidating and analyzing all relevant data to create and maintain awareness for your unit's area of responsibility and priority threats, including observed and potential threat components, indicators, and vulnerabilities discovered through your research

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be a United States citizen
- Must be able to obtain a Top Secret-SCI clearance
- Must be in compliance with the FBI Drug Policy
- Must have a Bachelor's degree with a GPA of 3.0 or higher, completed one full year of graduate level education, meet the definition of a graduating senior and expected to complete all degree requirements within nine months of application, or completed a Bachelor's degree outside of one of the designated fields of study and at least one year of entry-level work in a field related to cyber/STEM, national security, foreign area studies, foreign language, or law

SALARY INFORMATION: Base salary between \$35,359 and \$45,970 per year (doesn't include locality pay)
